So, you've found a group and a time that suits you.... now what?

We encourage the children to come join the Den / Pack / Troop for 3 or 4 weeks to 'try it out' before they officially join and then, when they are sure they want to get involved, they are 'invested' (get a uniform and join the group officially). During this time, there are no fees charged.

All you need to do to start is pitch up 5 mins before the meeting starts and introduce yourselves to any of the adult Scouters in uniform. They will ask you to sign a consent form which gives them some basic in-case of emergency contact information. You are welcome to hang around for the first few meetings to see them settle in or you can 'drop and go' depending on your child.

How often do they meet?

Meetings take place once a week at the time specified above for each group in line with the Government School Terms. There may be other activities and outings, but these are specific to each group and will be communicated to you by the Scouter in Charge each term.

What will it cost?

The monthly fee, in the tables above, covers the cost of the fee which we pay to Scouts South Africa for each Meerkat / Cub / Scout enrolled as well as the running costs of the hall.

There is also a once-off joining fee per child (to cover the cost of the scarf, woggle, T-shirt, badges, and booklet etc.) which a Meerkat / Cub / Scout receives when they are invested into the group. The joining fee is payable prior to Investiture. You will also need to purchase the uniform from the Scout Shop. (Shorts / Pants and Shirt, socks, and belt).

Where is the Hall situated?

The hall is situated at 22 Tinktinkie Street, next to the Boskruin Community Centre (Between the Bowling Club and Wendy's Playschool).
